Sustainable recycling relies on properly sorted material. Please follow these guidelines to ensure material is recycled.



## NEWSPAPER & MAGAZINES

Include inserts. Do not include: paper or plastic bags, phone books or hard/soft cover books. Remove and discard any plastic.

Place in the container marked NEWSPAPER.



## TIN CANS & ALUMINUM

Rinse cans and remove any paper labels. Place in separate compartment marked TIN CANS & ALUMINUM. Do not include: paint cans, appliances, hangers, fencing, scrap metal or aerosol cans.



## #1 & #2 PLASTIC BOTTLES

These must have a narrow neck and the #1 or #2 symbol on the bottom. Do not include: tubs, pails or buckets. Remove and discard caps.

Place in separate compartment marked MIXED PLASTIC.

## CARDBOARD & BOXBOARD

This includes corrugated cardboard boxes and dry goods boxes such as cereal, crackers, pasta dinner, shoe boxes, shirt boxes and brown paper bags. Do not include: Wax- or foil-coated boxes, beer or soda cartons (six packs, 12 packs, 24 packs) or any boxes that may be put in a refrigerator or freezer.

Break down boxes and discard any contents (e.g., Styrofoam, plastic bags, wood or food). Flatten cardboard boxes. Discard any packaging material (plastic, etc.). Place cardboard and boxboard in container marked CARDBOARD.

Please read all signs to be sure you place material in the proper container. There are three containers. The first container is for NEWSPAPER MIX (newspaper & magazines). The second container has three separate compartments, two for MIXED PLASTIC and one for TIN CANS & ALUMINUM. The third container is for CARDBOARD & BOXBOARD.
